## Terms and Conditions

### Eligibility

#### Traders

1. All traders' goods or products must be of Fairtrade and/or sustainable origin. Products or goods sold and/or promoted must comply with one or more of the following criteria:
  - i. Products or goods should be certified by the Fairtrade Foundation or equivalent bodies; **AND/OR**
  - ii. Products or goods should be traded in a fair and equitable manner so as to benefit marginalised communities overseas, including payment of a living wage to producers and workers, avoidance of child labour, the provision of a safe working environment, freedom of association and independent monitoring of standards; **AND/OR**
  - iii. Products or goods that deliver towards or support one or more of the following UN Sustainable Development Goals:
    - ✓ Goal 12: ensure sustainable consumption & production patterns
    - ✓ Goal 13: take urgent action to combat climate change & its impacts
    - ✓ Goal 15: protect, restore & promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt & reverse land degradation, and halt biodiversity loss

#### Campaigning Organisations

2. Groups should have stated aims which are compatible with those of Stockport Fairtrade Group e.g. Trade Justice, Human Rights, Sustainability.

#### Information Stalls

3. In addition, a limited number of information stalls may be available to other organisations, provided their business ethos is compatible with the aims of Stockport Fairtrade Group.

#### Applications

4. All applications for stalls must be made using the attached booking form.
5. If you have any access or operational requirements please indicate these on the booking form. These will be confirmed with you before attending the Fair.
6. No animals are allowed into the Guildhall except guide or hearing dogs.
7. **Stockport Fairtrade Group reserves the right to refuse an application for a stall at the Fair.**

#### Cancellations

8. There is a non-refundable charge of £20/£25 per stallholder, payable to 'Stockport Fairtrade Group, which must be paid in advance to secure a place. Bookings forms and payments should be sent by [chiamallia@hotmail.com](mailto:chiamallia@hotmail.com) by 22 October 2022.
9. If you are unable to take up your booking of a stall at the Fair, please let the Stockport Fairtrade Group know as far in advance as possible, by contacting the Group on 07803 928778.
10. Stalls are reserved until 10am on the day, after which unoccupied stalls will be re-allocated or removed.

#### Trading Terms

11. The Fair will be open to the public from **10.30am to 3pm**.
12. The Guildhall will be open from 8am on Saturday 19 November 2022 to stall holders.
13. There is free parking on site which is supervised by security staff employed by the Guildhall, which can be found at the rear of the venue and is accessed via Brentnall Street.
14. The Guildhall has Public Liability insurance for any instance related to the buildings, stairways, equipment, etc. but the Guildhall and Stockport Fairtrade Group cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or theft of or to property or persons in relation to equipment provided by stallholder. Please consider whether you require your own insurance.

#### Stalls

15. One table of approximately 1800 x 600 mm will be provided. Given the number of stallholders we are expecting, there will be limited space and so there may not be room available for additional shelving, stands, etc on the day. Additional tables are available at £5 each.
16. No nails, tacks or pins are to be inserted into any walls, upholstery or tables supplied by the Guildhall.
17. A distance of two feet (610 mm) is required between the stalls for fire regulations.
18. No smoking and no naked flames are permitted in the building. The burning of incense sticks is not permitted due to the smoke alarms.
19. Stockport Fairtrade Group expects each stallholder to clear away any rubbish generated by their stall at the end of the Fair. With the earlier finish time of 3pm, there will be plenty of time to vacate the premises by 4pm so we ask that stallholders do not dismantle their stalls before the end of the Fair; the last half hour can result in some good sales.
20. An electricity supply will not be available at the Fair.
21. Any COVID-19 protocols based on current government guidance or issued by Stockport Guildhall at the time of the Fair.
